

#### **Congratulations to Leaside Presbyterian!**

Our friends at Leaside Presbyterian Church (LPC) have good news to share. They have a new minister: Rev. Paul Kang. His induction service will be at 7:00 pm on Sunday, January 26, 2025. Some at Northlea may remember Paul when he was LPC's interim minister before the pandemic. Northlea and (LPC) have a long history of partnering for Good Friday services and during July and August. Since the fall of 2019, Northlea has supported financially, and with volunteers, **LPC's Community Time Program**. And since 2022, LPC has partnered with us in the community Fall Food Drive for Thorncliffe's Food Collaborative. Don't hesitate to let your LPC friends know that we at Northlea warmly welcome Paul and look forward to working with him serving our neighbours. Welcome Paul and Helen and family!

#### It's Muffin Month again!

As you see above, LPC is continuing with their Community Time Program, in which approximately 27-30 individuals in need participate. These individuals receive a Grocery Gift card and TTC fare card (two fares). That means it costs a little under \$30/person to run the program and each year Northlea United helps by raising funds to cover at least one month's costs — that's \$900. So, let's see if we can do it again, Northlea! You can make your cheque or envelope out to Northlea United and indicate Muffin Month on the memo line.
